- Competent in leading (25-40) students, ages 6-11, through sports and life-teaching moments

- Should be at least 21 years old.

- Creativity, problem solving, organizational, and multi-tasking skills are vital.
- Access to reliable transportation

**Responsibilities include but are not limited to:**

- Supervise and guide lesson/session delivery
- Work with other coaches and volunteers to create a positive learning environment
- Engage in communication with parents/guardians to express program expectations

**Special Requirements**

- Candidates will need to provide a letter of recommendation with their application
