Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Attend one practice per week for a weekly commitment of up to 2 hours maximum- (3:30 pm-5:00/5:30 pm – typical timeframe)
- Assist with the facilitation of the day's lesson plan by setting up and breaking down games and lessons.
- Participate in games and activities with the students as a role model.
- Work with coaches and volunteers to create a positive learning environment.
